



Celebrate wetlands month

May is national wetlands month. Local libraries will have mobile wetland displays on exhibit until the end of May. The displays were created by Environmental Concern in St. Michaels.

This year's theme is "Marshy Migrations: Journeys of a Lifetime." The display features three migration stories told from a bird's perspective. At the library, kids can check out books to find out more about wetlands or participate in one of the "Books, Bogs and Bug" programs Environmental Concern offers.

The display will be at Stevensville and Centreville libraries until Tuesday, May 27. The display will be available from May 27 to 31 at the Sudlersville Library.

To celebration wetlands month, Environmental Concern suggests reading a book about wetlands, encouraging children to submit an illustration for the Write On! Wetlands Challenge, visit a wetland such as the Blackwater National Wildlife Refuge, write a letter to a local official asking them to support wetlands or donate time or resources to your favorite wetland organization.
