POW! THE PLANNING OF WETLANDS



Learn how to build a schoolyard wetland with your students with POW! The Planning of Wetlands: 1, 2, or 3-day workshops for 7th-12th grade formal and non-formal educators.

Using POW! a class of students decided to build a home. They didn't use planks of wood, hammers or nails. Instead they used aquatic plants and shovels to create a home for wildlife, a home called a wetland. While creating this vital resource, students gained life skills, reinforced concepts learned in school and felt empowered by making a positive difference in their community.

POW!'s 25 activities allow the students to transform their schoolyard into a living and breathing wetland. Together, they will survey the school's grounds, apply for necessary permits, develop a water budget, design the wetland, choose native plants, and build the wetland.

WOW! THE WONDERS OF WETLANDS



Bring wetlands into the classroom with WOW! The Wonders of Wetlands: 1-day workshop for K-12 formal and non-formal educators.

Educators respond to WOW! because it fulfills their need for a single resource, is highly adaptable to all subjects and all ages and its activities are easy, fun and inexpensive. The 1-day workshop introduces educators to the three parameters of wetlands (vegetation, soils, hydrology) and wetland functions and values through the activities – for instance...

- Assemble a dip net with a kitchen sieve and a broom handle
- Build a watershed model using a paint pan
- Get kids' hearts racing with a nutrient tag game
- Explore urban planning with hydropoly and regulation rummy
- Reinforce the concept of metaphors with a pillow case
- Dissect a cattail
- Study soil percolation rates with a coffee tin and kitty litter
